# TFS Trial Form Support awarded European Master Agreement for the supply of Contract Placement Services

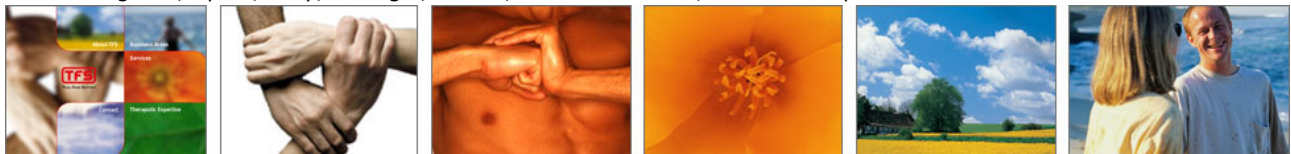
